



<b>Time Line:</b>	<p><b>May 15th:</b> Declaration of interest to host</p> <p><b>May 31st:</b> Bid complete, provisional budget</p> <p><b>June 15th:</b> Last changes to budget</p> <p><b>June 30th:</b> Shortlist by EUF</p> <p><b>Beginning of August:</b> Bid selection</p>
<b>Contact:</b>	All mails shall be send to <b>youth@euf.efdf.org</b>
<b>Tournament length:</b>	<b>5 full days</b> (team arrival Monday evening, departure Saturday 17:00 or Sunday morning).
<b>Date:</b>	Target Date is <b>Aug.5th-10th. 2013</b> As an alternative the week after can be considered. The week before should be avoided since Worlds U23 are on July 22 <sup>nd</sup> -28 <sup>th</sup> .
<b>Number of Teams:</b>	There should be space for about <b>45</b> teams
<b>Number of Players:</b>	In the previous events the average number of players was around 18-20, including staff and coaches.
<b>Venue:</b>	<p><b>Minimum 8 WFDF-conform fields</b> (between 100m x 37m + 5m restrain lines around and 90m x 33m + 3m restrain lines) are necessary. Please provide backup plan in case of rain (e.g. additional fields available, turf fields, etc.)</p> <p>Football goals must be removed or protected, for the safety of the players.</p> <p>Having all pitches on 1 site is an asset.</p> <p>Having a grand stand for showcase games is an asset.</p> <p>Please add in the bid a google map link of the venue(s) and describe the grass quality.</p>
<b>Staff/Volunteers:</b>	<p>Please consider 2 Person per field/game plus at least 3-4 persons to manage schedule, spirit-scorings, volunteers, etc.</p> <p>EUF usually supports the Tournament Organization Committee with 2 experienced Youth Event Coordinators, who normally get free lodging and food as all volunteers. Please consider the costs for these two extra volunteers in your budget.</p> <p>First Aid-Kit must be available at the fields. Medical staff and/or physiotherapists are highly recommended. Fix ambulance at the fields is an asset.</p> <p>Please describe your medical plan in your bid.</p>
<b>Accommodation:</b>	<p>Low budget (floor space, camping, hostels,...) accommodation must be offered.</p> <p>Price range for the various accommodations must be indicated in the budget.</p> <p>Please add in the bid a google map link of the accommodation and the distance to the venue(s).</p>
<b>Food:</b>	<p>At least breakfast and warm dinner must be provided.</p> <p>Drinking water must be available at each pitch.</p> <p>Please indicate where and how you plan to provide meals and the indicative costs.</p>



<p><b>Reachability:</b></p>	<p>Indicate how the tournament location can be reached (distance to airports, public transportation system,...).</p> <p>If a shuttle service is necessary between accommodation and venue(s) indicate the planned costs and how it will be organized.</p> <p>Indicate if you plan a pickup service from the next Airport / Train Station.</p> <p>Having a tournament location, which minimizes the travelling costs and so reduces the overheads of moving large groups of kids, is an asset.</p>
<p><b>Social Events:</b></p>	<p>Open ceremony on Monday evening including show case game. Closing Ceremony on Saturday afternoon. Both of them will be run together with one EUF delegate.</p> <p>Trading night and a farewell party. EUF like WFDF has a strict no-alcohol policy for all youth events.</p> <p>Please shortly describe the plan for the social events.</p>
<p><b>Media Visibility:</b></p>	<p>The first goal for a tournament organization must be that the customers (=the players) get what they came for: good regular fields, smooth organization of the competition.</p> <p>Secondary EUF events can be used by local Ultimate associations to get a better visibility which should help getting sponsors and, on the middle term, new players.</p> <p>Please indicate if and how you plan to increase the tournament visibility and which budget you reserve for this.</p>
<p><b>Gifts/Trophies:</b></p>	<p>Medals will be paid by EUF.</p> <p>Spirit of the Game and Winner Trophies must be covered by the tournament budget or by sponsors.</p> <p>A tournament gift per player is not necessary and should be considered only if covered by a sponsor.</p>
<p><b>Budget:</b></p>	<p>Tournament costs to the individual player including travel costs will be a central criterion for bid selection.</p> <p>As a reference consider that the previous EYUC had a budget of about 200€ per player, including accommodation, food (HB), player's fee and share of the team fee. For the budget plan, please use the EUF template.</p> <p>We want to make clear that people, who work hard on these events, should receive some reasonable payment, nevertheless, being a youth competition, management costs should be kept to the minimum.</p> <p>The EUF committee wants to make sure that it is able to get very clear visibility of all the costs; that costs are reasonable, and that we help make sure players don't pay for things that they might prefer not to have if given the choice.</p>
