The year 2020 seems a small year from a budget point of view with only one big tourney (EUICC end of January) and then of course very few live actions when COVID struck. But 2020 also marked the start of EU-GEM. End of 2019, after a lot of work by former EUF secretary Alia Ayub, the EUF was granted an Erasmus Plus fund of over 50.000 euro to setup a manual about equity amongst trainers and coaches. The board decided to account this money in 2020, with in February the start of the whole EU-GEM project with a live weekend meeting in Vienna.

In 2020 during the COVID-19 pandemia the EUF board used their time for a more transparent accounting, setting up files in a google drive with all the invoices over all the years going back to 2013. Special thanks to Oddi for all this work ! The links to these files were then put in the accounting spreadsheet. This was done to make the yearly check by the two auditors easier and to better comply with the good-governance requirements.

With the indoor tournament and the Erasmus Plus grant, in 2020 EUF made a nice profit of over 33.000 euro, the biggest yearly profit ever. Then again one should take into account that greater part of that money is earmarked for EU-GEM.



# EUF Financial Status - Auditor Comments

Auditor Matthias Zaccarin had a question about the two separate profit posts of EUICC. The treasurer answered that one post was payment for the EUF staff, the commentators of the livestreams and the photographer, both travel costs and 'expenses'. The other post was the normal EUF fee of 1 euro per player per day that EUF asks at every tournament. The actual profit was put in reserve for the EUIC 2022. This answer satisfied Matthias :

"I can now approve the accounting and in addition I would like to give my compliments to the treasurer and executive board for improving the layout and overview of the excel file."

New auditor Lubomir Botev went through all the files from 2020 very thoroughly and saw several invoices that he didn't recognize in the accounting spreadsheet. After explanation by the treasurer that several invoices were remade in 2021 (when we started our transparency policy) and that one invoice was paid by and then refunded to another EU-GEM participant, Lubomir too was satisfied :

"Now it makes sense, so everything looks OK! I can also approve the accounting."
