Question by Sofia (POR): Will there still be EUCR's? Nemo: yes, these first three years we still continue them and are preparing a call for bids soon.

Question by Dmytro (UKR): Why is the Eastern region changing and an extra bid is going to CZE? Oddi: There aren't enough bids to give all countries a guaranteed bid. Countries with smaller competitions should play together before EUCR, to determine who gets a bid. Bids are determined by last year's results, that's why CZE Open received an extra bid.

Comment by Simon (UK): I would like to say that EUF is run quite well nowadays and would like to thank you all for your time and energy.

Comment by Sofia (POR): We have seen from COVID that in (near) future it will be very important to set good time lines for tournaments.

Question by Tudor (ROM): We are not recognised by the ministry in our country, can we have support from EUF on pursuing this? Oddi: It's probably best to do this via WFDF first. So please contact Volker Bernardi.

Question by Ulla (FIN): When do we know the date for EUCR's? Oddi: There are 3 dedicated dates, but you can decide on that within your region.
